

SAT

2016/2017

- The SAT assesses your reading, writing, and math skills and is approximately 4 1/2 hours long. Most colleges accept SAT scores.
- There are also over 20 different SAT subject tests you can take that allow you to showcase achievement in specific subjects. These tests are 1 hour long and you can take up to 3 of them on any given test date.
- You may not take the SAT on the same day as the subject tests

- The ACT assesses your skills in English, reading, science, and math and is approximately 4 hours long. Many colleges accept ACT scores.
 - You may also add a writing assessment to your ACT.
- Please contact the specific college for advice on whether they accept ACT scores and if they prefer the writing with those scores.
