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Dear Kinect Middle School Academy parents and students,

Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! Mandatory student and parent orientation will be on Monday August 2nd and Tuesday August 3rd.

You must attend **one** of the orientations. Please plan on orientation lasting about one hour.

Wednesday August 4th- 8:15 a.m.- 12:15 p.m. All students will report to their classes.

Thursday August 5th- 8:15 a.m.- 12:15 p.m. All students will report to their classes.

Friday August 6th Homeschool day

The Regular school day will run from 8:15 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. with an optional study hall from 1:30-2:20 p.m. At 1:30 p.m. students need to either be picked up or attend study hall until 2:20 p.m. Students cannot “hang out” around campus between 1:30 p.m.-2:20 p.m.. Students need to be picked up no later than 2:20 p.m.

As part of preparation for classes it is important for students to note the following:

Dress Code –

Please be sure to dress appropriately. Inappropriately dressed students will be issued a detention, offered a clothing substitute, and possibly sent home. Students will wear athletic attire at all times. This consists of athletic shoes, shirts, sweatshirts, shorts, and sweats. Students will not be allowed to wear jeggings, jeans or any open toed shoes. Detention will be issued for students out of dress code.
